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SANBAH CUP 2022 FORMAT

16's Boys: 40 competitors in 10 heats of 4.

14's Boys: 28 competitors in 7 heats of 4.

Girls: 20 competitors in 5 heats of 4.

This format is intended to give everyone two surfs then pick out the top performers from the two rounds. A top performance in both rounds is vital.

Round 1 Seeding Round:

There will be no eliminations, just points allocated for each place.

Round 1 Place points allocation of 1st = 8 pts, 2nd = 6 pts, 3rd = 3 pts, 4th = 1.5 pts.

Round 2 Qualifying Round: all competitors will advance from the first round and seeded depending on placing, with no competitor competing against someone that they have already competed against.

Round 2 Place points allocation of 1st = 15 pts, 2nd = 11 pts, 3rd = 3 pts, 4th = 1.5.

After the qualifying round, the allocated place points from both rounds are added and the top placing competitors will progress to the finals.

NOTE: First and second placed competitors in round 2 will not automatically be in the finals if the first round result is poor and others have better results.

In the 16's Boys, the top 16 competitors will progress to the quarter-finals.

In the Girls and 14's Boys, the top 8 competitors will progress to the semi-final.

The surfers to progress to the finals will be seeded firstly on the allocated place points from two rounds, then on the "wave score tally".

If there are a number of competitors vying for the last position in the Finals then the surfer with the highest accumulated "wave score tally" will progress.
